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### **JOB DESCRIPTION**

- Adequately prepare for each class. Understand and implement the curriculum being taught.
- Work with administration staff and director to make sure all supplies, tools and curriculum are ordered for classes.
- Control and monitor all inventory/tools/equipment used as a part of teaching classes.
- Implement adult learning principles in the classroom.
- Assign grades and fill out progress reports for apprentices. Submit forms to administration for mailing.
- Mentoring and guiding apprentices through training and the process of become a journey-level worker while taking classes at the training center.
- Perform periodic building maintenance at training center facility as needed.

- Be a team player and possess attributes of flexibility in aiding to meet the needs of the council, contractors and director when it relates to training needs.
- Have excellent verbal and written communication skills to professionally represent the organization.
