Pewaukee Skill Enhancement Classes

American Red Cross CPR/First Aid/AED:

8-hour course. This class provides a First Aid/CPR/AED qualification.

Construction Fall Protection:

8-hour course. This Construction Fall Protection class addresses safety requirements when working from an elevated area and covers how to recognize and properly address hazards in our industry.

10-hour course. This class deals with the characteristics of confined space and requirements for a permit-required confined space program. Atmospheric hazards are described along with the methods of and time requirements for ventilation, and procedures for monitoring air quality.

12-hour course. This class covers welding safety basics and includes 8 hours of shop time.

Mass Timber:

8-hour course. This class explains firestop systems and how they are used to control and contain a fire. The class also discusses building codes and how they relate to firestop installation.

8-hour course. Written and hands-on assessment of your knowledge and application of the following areas:

MEWP's:

24 hour course. This workshop will cover Heavy and Mass Timber Construction materials, job planning, tools, and installation best practices used. Mass Timber is a new category of large, engineered wood columns, beams, and panels that provide exceptional strength, stability, and fire resistance. The reading of structural and shop drawings, common connections for columns, beams, and panels, field modifications, and moisture management products will be

Prerequisite: None

Open Welding:

8-hour course. These sessions allow for members of varying skill to become proficient welders. During these classes you will have the ability to test and become certified in multiple processes.

Prerequisite: Must have welding knowledge, taken Hot Work Permit or Intro to Welding, or have been taught welding safety protocols.

PITO Refresher:

8-hour course. Formally known as aerial lift, covers safety issues and guidelines for mobile elevating work platforms that can be driven in an extended position and moves both inside and outside tipping lines. Class includes classroom theory, 50 question exam, and the required practical for Group A, Type 3 and Group B, Type 3. This class is the ANSI approved training for Mobile Elevated Work Platform operation.

PITO Industrial & Rough Terrain:

16-hour course. This class introduces many kinds of lift trucks—their components and applications. The text focuses on industrial lift trucks and rough terrain lift trucks.

Prerequisite: None

Minimum 1 hour per student.
Members must be observed by a qualified instructor inspecting the work area, inspecting a forklift, and driving a forklift prior to expiring. This class refreshes either the Industrial, the Rough Terrain, or both.

16-hour course. This class refreshes 40 hour Rigging Course

12-hour course. The Solid Surfaces class provides in-depth instruction in the technical aspects of working with solid surface material. The course covers epoxy, joining solid surfaces and proper surface finishing.

Wall Panel Awareness:

This class will serve as an exploration into the skills of wall panel installation in an application-based class. Lay-out, cutting techniques, bending techniques, and application methods will be explored in the shop. Welding techniques for wall and floor applications will also be learned and practiced
