

CHILDREN OF MEMBERS

The Regional Council offers scholarships to dependents of members to help them pursue post-secondary education.

Applicants in 2025 received \$1,500 scholarships. The amount awarded for the 2026 scholarships will be determined after January 1, 2026.

Eligibility

To be eligible for this scholarship, graduating students must:

- Have a parent or guardian who is a member in good standing of a UBC Local within the NCSRCC jurisdiction that is participating in the Scholarship Fund.
- Be enrolled full-time (12 credit hours) in an accredited post-secondary program.
- Submit a post-secondary transcript, along with their application, showing a completed semester as a full-time student with passing grades.
- Provide a brief essay (500 words or less) on what benefits have you realized through the advancement of the Labor Movement.
- Applicants pursuing a degree in a construction-related field will be considered for an additional \$500 in scholarship money.
