## NCSRCC Northern Minnesota Bargaining 2023

#### Tentative Agreement Summary

## Language

- 1. Employers are required to have adequate, safe and secure facilities on each job to accommodate nursing mothers.
- 2. Housekeeping changes including incorporating the pension transition, and additional \$1.11 contribution from employers into the Agreement. Currently, the pension transition is documented in a Memorandum of Agreement.
- 3. Language establishing the metro and southern MN rates as applicable under the CBA with home funding allowed.
- 4. Language allowing the employers to increase their industry fund to 6 cents, which is over and above the total package.

## **Economics**

Four year agreement negotiated to close the gap as much as possible with the Twin Cities Metro.
