

WHAT DO I DO NOW?

Questions to ask an employee who reports they have COVID-19.

1. What date did you first feel ill or had your positive test collected?
_____ subtract 2 days = _____ (first day they could spread it to others)
2. When did you start to self-isolate?
_____ (last date they could spread to others)
3. Did you work between these two days (this is called the period of communicability)?
 - Did not work = no workplace exposure
 - Did work, continue to question #4
4. Which job site or building location were you at each day?
5. What was your physical location and task?
6. Did you have a fabric face covering or mask on while at work?
7. Where you within 6 feet of any other individuals for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period starting from 2 days before illness onset or had your test collected?

Notify site of possible exposure but do not include source name. Close area used by individual and arrange cleaning and disinfection. Individual needs to remain in home isolation for 14 days after first date of illness or date of test collection (which ever occurred first).
